We hope you enjoy this issue!



On December 27, 1996, during the VH1 Pop-Up Video Program on Cable TV, ALF was mentioned in Sting's new video "I'm So Happy". The video incorporated a futuristic science fiction/western theme. The blurb referred to Sting's real name as Gordon Sumner, and compared to it was our very own Gordon Shumway! This video is often aired in the Pop-Up Video line up.

On Sunday, January 12, 1997, ALF made a cameo appearance in one of the funniest Simpson's episodes ever. ALF CHATS ON AMERICA ON LINE

Before subscribers had difficulty accessing 'America on Line', Alf, Paul Fusco, and questioners from around the country had a chance to chat on the eve of the premiere of "Project Alf" which aired Saturday, February 17, 1996 on ABC. The following are some highlights of this momentous conversation.

Q: PAUL & ALF, DID YOU READ THE ALF COMIC BOOK MARVEL COMICS PUBLISHED IN THE 80's? WHAT DID YOU THINK OF IT?

ALF: CLASSIC LITERATURE!

PAUL: ALF IS BEING MODEST AGAIN.

Q: WHY DID THE SHOW END ON SUCH A CLIFF-HANGER...AND WHAT ACTUALLY HAPPENED!!!???

MANUFACTURER'S NOTEBOOK

We try to be as complete as possible when listing the items produced by a company. Any errors or omissions are solely ours.

> In this issue we cover---Russ Berrie Corp. Oakland. N.J.

Russ Berrie produces small gift type items found primarily in card shops, gift shops, toy stores and occasionally in convenience stores and even department stores. All Russ Berrie items(with the exception of the mugs) came on some type of display stand.

Magnets-Eight different magnets. 2 1/4" diameter buttons with magnet on back. Each has a white background with a caricature of ALF and a short saying. They came 25 to a display stand. The stand is light blue metal 16" tall and 12" wide with a drawing of ALF in a director's chair at the top. 1987 Alien Productions Style no. 3077

Puffy Stickers-Stickers came on a card of eight different. The card is 8" tall by 3 1/2" wide covered in cellophane with a folded cardboard header stapled to the top. The display box is light green. 8" square by 2 3/4" deep illustrated with various caricatures from the stickers. 1987 Alien Prod. Item # 2451 contains 6 dozen.

Keyrings Plastic card type. There are 12 different white plastic cards 3 3/8" x 2 1/8". Each with a color drawing and saying with a gold colored keyring attached. The stand is a light blue plastic covered metal wire rack with light blue cardboard backing and a seperate light blue cardboard header that pictures ALF in a directors chair.

The rack comes with three rows of four hooks. 1987 Alien Prod. Item # 9480

■ Bumper stickers--Six different stickers with a white background and color caricatures of ALF with saying. Displayed on a 20 3/4" tall by 15 1/4" wide dark blue cardboard stand with two different caricatures taken from the bumper stickers. A clear plastic slotted piece holds the stickers. 1987 #6579

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- Mugs--Each white ceramic mug has a different drawing and saying and comes in its own 4" cube shaped white box with a color picture the same as the mug. On top of the box is TO: and FROM: There are six different mugs. The mugs are 3 5/8" tall and 3 3/8" diameter. 1987 Mugs item # 8473 Boxes style #8600
- Furry clip-ons-These 3" tall figures have moveable heads and clamping arms. Each comes with an attached hang tag that is folded to form a 1" tall by 1 1/8" wide red tag with ALF in yellow print. They are displayed on a white nylon rope with a 3 1/2" diameter light blue cardboard header tag with ALF picture. It is folded over the rope to form two identical sides. 1987 #1399
- Large furry clip-ons--Similar to above only six inches tall attached hang tag is larger and the rope display header tag is 5 1/4" diameter. 1988 #1398 12 to a rope.
- Fuzzy (lapel) pins--Pin depicts ALFs' face and is approx. 1 1/4" tall and is three dimensional. They are displayed 36 pins on a light blue cardboard stand 15" tall by 13" wide. At the top is a drawing of ALF in a directors chair. 1988 #1316


Erasers--ALF colored rubber eraser with handpainted faces in three styles, two sitting poses and one standing. Six dozen erasers come in a 9" long by 7" wide by 3" deep blue cardboard box that the top opens on to become a display box. The box is illustrated with caricatures of the actual erasers. 1988 #8726


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Dencils--Two different color pencils with two different style toppers. One top has ALF from the waist up and the other is ALF standing with his arms outstretched. One color is blue with "Hey, No Droblem" and the other is red with "I'm A Deople Alien". The display is 5 1/4" diameter and 4" tall clear plastic tub with a dark blue label that has a drawing of ALF saying "Yo... ALF pencil with topper" 1988 #9723

Keychains...Hard plastic figures in the same 3 styles as the erasers with a gold colored chain and ring attached. The display stand is a white plastic covered wire rack with a light blue cardboard backing and an attached cardboard header that pictures ALF in a red convertible. It is 19" tall by 13" wide. It contains six dozen figural keychains on two rows of six hooks. 1988 #4410

Display stand variation--similar wire rack on a plastic base.
